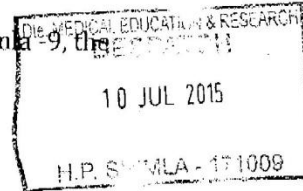

Medical/Dental and private un-aided Dental Colleges of the State of Himachal Pradesh i.e. **Indira Gandhi Government Medical College, Shimla , Dr. Rajindera Prasad Government Medical College, Kangra at Tanda , Himachal Pradesh Government Dental College, Shimla , Himachal Dental College, Sundernagar, Distt. Mandi (Pvt.), Bhojia Dental College, Nalagarh(Baddi), Distt. Solan (pvt.), MNDV Dental College, Tatul, Distt. Solan (pvt.) , Himachal Institute of Dental Sciences, Paonta Sahib, Distt. Sirmour(pvt.)** for the academic session 2015-16 on the basis of merit of qualifying examinations i.e. 10+2 or its equivalent examinations in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology. The candidates must have passed the qualifying examinations with the aforesaid subjects and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry & Biology/Biotechnology in qualifying examinations. In case of the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC, the marks obtained in PCB shall be 40% . For persons with locomotry disability of lower limbs, minimum of 45% marks in PCB for Gen. PH and 40% marks in PCB for SC/ST/OBC-PH are required.

NRI students means wards of Indian citizen residing abroad and have passed their qualifying examination i.e. 12th standard from schools /Colleges /Universities situated in the abroad which is equivalent to 10+2 Higher/Senior Secondary Examination or any other examinations equivalent thereto with Indian qualification of 10+2 . The equivalence certificate to be furnished with the application form which should be issued by the Association of Indian Universities, AIU House, 16, Inderjeet Gupta Marg, New Delhi-110002. In the equivalence certificate, it should be clearly mentioned that the candidate has passed 10+2 with the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology and English individually with the required percentage of marks in order to avoid any confusion at the time of admission.

Submission of Application Form and Fee: The application form complete in all respects alongwith fee of US \$ 100 or equivalent in rupees in the shape of bank draft drawn in favour of the Principal of the concerned college alongwith photocopies of requisite self-attested certificates is required to be sent by air-mail/speed-post/registered-post directly to the Principal of the colleges concerned, so as to reach on or before 14.8.2015. Information bulletin regarding admission to MBBS/BDS courses under NRI Quota in Govt. Medical/Dental Colleges and private Dental Colleges of the State of Himachal Pradesh (India) for the academic session 2015-16.

1. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA, SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORM AND CERTIFICATES

(i) NRI students means wards of Indian citizen residing abroad and have passed their qualifying examination i.e. 12th standard from the Schools/Colleges/Universities situated in the abroad which is equivalent to 10+2 Higher/Senior Secondary Examination or any other examinations equivalent thereto with requisite subjects and percentage of marks.

(ii) The interested candidates who fulfill the eligibility criteria as prescribed for seeking admission to MBBS/BDS courses under NRI Quota seats in Govt. Medical/Dental Colleges and private un-aided Dental Colleges of the State of Himachal Pradesh may apply on the prescribed Application Form Appendix-4 as available on the websites (i) www.hpuniv.in (ii) www.hp.gov.in/hpdmer (iii) www.igmcshimla.org (iv) www.rpgmc.ac.in (v) www.hpgdcshimla.org

However, they must have to possess the minimum educational qualifications with required percentage of marks and age limit as prescribed for these courses. The candidates are required to submit their application form complete in all respects directly to the Principal(s) of the colleges concerned alongwith requisite documents/certificates and fee of US \$ 100 or equivalent in rupees in the shape of bank draft to be drawn in favour of the Principal of the Colleges concerned which must reach in their office **on or before 14.8.2015**. In case a candidate wants to apply for more than one colleges, he/she may apply separately to the colleges concerned on the said prescribed application form with requisite fee. The selection will be made on the basis of merit of the qualifying examination in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology.

The NRI candidates will have to produce a certificate of equivalence of their qualifying examination showing therein the aggregate percentage of marks in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology as well as individual percentage of English subject duly issued by the Association of Indian Universities, AIU House, 16, Inderjeet Gupta Marg, New Delhi-110002.

(iii) The photocopies of the following documents/certificates duly self-attested must be submitted by the NRI candidates with Application Form in support of their claim for seeking admission under NRI seats and requisite fee i.e. US \$ 100 or equivalent in rupees in the shape of Bank Draft drawn in favour of the Principal of the Colleges concerned within stipulated period as prescribed directly to the Principals of the concerned College(s):-

- (a) A copy of Non-Resident Indian Card/Employment Card issued by the Employer.
- (b) A copy of Immigration/Employment visa entry on the passport along with the details of the Passport.

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- (c) A copy of certificate issued by the Indian Embassy/High Commission in the Country

where the NRI is residing.

(d) A copy of the latest assessment order of the income authority, either in India or in the country of Employment filed in the status of Non-Resident Indian.

(e) A copy of having passed the Matriculation or its equivalent examination showing date of birth.

(f) A copy of having passed the plus one or its equivalent examination from abroad.

(g) A certificate of good conduct/character from the Principal of the School/College as per **Appendix A-1**.

(h) A copy of having passed the qualifying examination (10+2 or its equivalent) from abroad.

(i) A copy of equivalence certificate duly issued by the Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi.

(iv) Duration of Courses in the Colleges:

(i) M.B.B.S. : 5 ½ years

(ii) B.D.S.: 5 Years

2. INFORMATION REGARDING COLLEGES

1. Indira Gandhi Medical College, Shimla

(i) Himachal Pradesh Medical College, Shimla, now known as Indira Gandhi Medical College (IGMC), Shimla (name changed/incorporated vide Himachal Pradesh Govt. Notification No.HFW (Cha) 4-3/84, dated 7.11.1984) started functioning in August, 1966 in the old Snowdon Hospital building with 50 admissions. Subsequently, the admission capacity of the college was increased to 65 seats in the year 1978 and 100 seats from the academic session 2010-2011 on year to year permission basis. The Institution is recognized by the Medical Council of India and is affiliated with the H.P. University, Shimla. Indira Gandhi Hospital, Shimla, Kamla Nehru State Hospital for Mothers & Children and Medical Institutions situated in the Mashobra Block are associated with this college for the purpose of imparting practical training to the graduate students.

(ii) Presently I.G.M.C.Shimla is running MBBS Degree, PG Degree (MD/MS) and PG Diploma's Courses of Himachal Pradesh University. The duration of MBBS Course is 4 ½ years followed by one year compulsory rotatory internship. The students will only become eligible for the award of MBBS degree after satisfactory completion of the course and the internship training. This is however subject to amendments by the Medical Council of India and Himachal Pradesh University from time to time.

2. Dr. Rajendra Prasad Govt. Medical College, Kangra at Tanda

Dr. Rajendra Prasad Govt. Medical College, Kangra at Tanda was started functioning from the academic session 1997-98 with intake capacity of 50 seats. Subsequently, the admission capacity was increased from 50 to 100 seats from the academic session 2011-12 on year to year permission basis. It is situated at Tanda 4 kms from Kangra. It is running MBBS Degree, PG Degree (MD/MS) and PG Diploma's Courses of Himachal Pradesh University. The Hospital of the Dr. Rajendra Prasad Govt. Medical College Kangra at Tanda has been made functional from 3.12.2007. The Nagrota Bhagwan Block and its associated Medical Institutions are attached with the College

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for imparting of clinical/practical training in rural and urban areas. The duration of MBBS course is 4 ½ years followed by one year compulsory rotator internship .The

students are eligible for the award of MBBS degree only after satisfactory completion of the course and the internship training. This is however subject to amendments by the Medical Council of India and Himachal Pradesh University from time to time.

3. H.P. Govt. Dental College & Hospital, Shimla

The Govt. of Himachal Pradesh has started BDS course in Himachal Pradesh Govt. Dental College Shimla with 20 admissions from the session 1994-95. Presently, the sanctioned intake capacity of the College is 60 students. The duration of BDS Course shall be four academic years followed by one year rotatory internship. A student becomes eligible for the award of BDS degree only after satisfactory completion of the course including internship. This is however subject to amendments by the Dental Council of India and Himachal Pradesh University from time to time.

4. Himachal Dental College Sundernagar, District Mandi

A privately managed Dental College at Sundernagar, District Mandi has started BDS course with intake capacity of 60 seats since 1994. The duration of course shall be four academic years followed by one year rotatory internship. A student becomes eligible for the award of BDS degree only after satisfactory completion of the course including internship. This is however subject to amendments by the Dental Council of India and Himachal Pradesh University from time to time.

5. MN DAV Dental College Tatul, District Solan

A privately managed Dental College at Tatul District Solan has started BDS course with intake capacity of 60 seats since 1998. The duration of course shall be four academic years followed by one year rotatory internship. A student becomes eligible for the award of BDS degree only after satisfactory completion of the course including internship. This is however subject to amendments by the Dental Council of India and Himachal Pradesh University from time to time.

6. Bhojia Dental College & Hospital Budh (Nalagarh) District Solan.

A privately managed Dental College at Budh (Nalagarh) District Solan has started BDS course with intake capacity of 60 seats since 1999. The duration of course shall be four academic years followed by one year rotatory internship. A student becomes eligible for the award of BDS degree only after satisfactory completion of the course including internship. This is however subject to amendments by the Dental Council of India and Himachal Pradesh University from time to time.

7. Himachal Institute of Dental Sciences Paonta Sahib, District Sirmour.

A privately managed Dental College at Paonta Sahib, District Sirmour has started BDS course with intake capacity of 100 seats since 2003. The duration of course shall be four academic years followed by one year rotatory internship. A student becomes eligible for the award of BDS degree only after satisfactory completion of the course including internship. This is however subject to amendments by the Dental Council of India and Himachal Pradesh University from time to time.

NOTE : *The above Institutions are affiliated to Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla.*

**Note: The admission for 2 seats in Dr. R.P.GMC Tanda will be made only if the permission for renewal of 50 additional permitted seats will be received from the Medical Council of India and Govt. of India for the Academic Session 2015-16. The seats can be increased/decreased as per MCI/DCI directions.*

4. Educational Qualifications and Other Conditions: Candidates should have passed in any one of the following qualifying examination at the time of counselling:-
a) The Higher/Senior Secondary Examination or the Indian School Certificate Examination which is equivalent to 10+2 Higher/Senior Secondary Examination after a period of 12 years study, the last two years of such study comprising of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-technology(which shall include practical tests in these subjects) and Mathematics or any other elective subject with English at a level not less than the core course for English as prescribed by the National Council of Educational Research and Training after introduction of the 10+2+3 educational structure as recommended by the National Committee on Education.

OR

B.Sc. Examination of an Indian University provided that he/she has passed the B.Sc. Examination with not less than two of the subjects Physics, Chemistry, Biology(Botany, Zoology)/Bio-technology and further that he/she has passed the earlier qualifying examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English.

OR

Any other examinations which in scope and standard (Last 2 years of 10+2 study comprising of Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Bio-technology; Which shall include practical test in these subjects.) is found to be equivalent to the intermediate Science Examination of an Indian University/Board, taking Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Bio-technology including practical tests in each of these subjects and English.

Provided that to be eligible for admission, candidate must have passed any of the qualifying examinations as enumerated above or appearing in the qualifying examination in 2015. Provided also that to be eligible for seeking admission, the candidate must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-technology and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology

at the qualifying examination as mentioned in clause (2) of regulation 4 on Graduate Medical Education 1997 for admission to MBBS/BDS courses subject to fulfillment of eligibility criteria as prescribed.

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In respect of the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled tribes or Other Backward Classes, the marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry and Bio.ogy/Bio-technology taken together in qualifying examination shall be 40% marks instead of 50% marks for General candidates. Further, for persons with locomotory disability of lower limbs, minimum of 45% marks for Gen-PH and 40% marks for SC-PH/ST-PH/OBC-PH are required.

Provided further that the students studied abroad seeking admission into Medical/Dental Colleges in India must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-technology and English upto the 12 standard level with 50% marks as mentioned above and their equivalency shall be determined as per regulations of the Medical Council of India by the Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi.

Note: Marks obtained in Mathematics are not to be considered for admission to MBBS/BDS courses.

(d) The Candidate should have already completed or should complete the age of 17 years and must have completed 25 years of upper age on 31st December of the year of his/her admission to the first year MBBS/BDS course. The Applications of candidates who do not fulfill the age requirements will be summarily rejected.

Date of birth as recorded in the Matriculation/Higher Secondary Certificate/Indian School Certificate will only be valid. The candidate must born on or between 1.1.1991 to 1.1.1999 (for all categories).

(e) Criteria for Physically Handicapped:

The candidate must possess a valid document certifying his/her physical disability conforming to judgment of Supreme Court of India. i.e. one category viz, physically handicapped with locomotory disorders and that too with permanent disability of lower limbs between 50% to 70%. The disability certificate should be produced from a duly constituted and authorized Medical Board of the State or the Central Government Hospitals/Institutions and should be issued within three months prior to submission of his/her application for seeking admission in a medical course for claiming the benefit of reservation as per **Appendix A-2**. Provided further that in case no such candidates are available in that category, then only candidates with disability of lower limbs between 40% to 50% shall be considered for admission

5. COUNSELLING AND ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The Counselling will be conducted in the last week of August, 2015 by the colleges concerned by constituting a Committee on the different dates. The candidates are required to present himself/herself alongwith original documents/certificates. The prescribed fee shall be paid by the candidates in the shape of Bank Draft/By Cash within a week time after allotment of seat in the concerned college, failing which admission shall stand cancelled without any further correspondence and seat will be allotted to next candidate in order of merit.

6. MEDICAL EXAMINATION & REGISTRATION

1. The selected candidates will be called for medical examination and verification of the

documents attached to the original application in the Medical / Dental College on their own expenses.

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2. The students who take admission in MBBS / BDS courses should get vaccinated with anti-hepatitis-B themselves at their own expenses and they are required to do so within 6 months from the date of their admission in the respective courses.
3. The standard of physical fitness will be as prescribed in **Appendix-A-3** if declared unfit he/she will not be admitted in the College. The said prescribed form of physical fitness is available with the College office. Any disability like colour blindness will be considered as medical unfitness for admission to MBBS/BDS courses.
4. If the selected candidate does not join the college by the stipulated date and complete the Medical Examination etc. as laid down in the prescribed form he/she will not have any claim for the allotted seat, which will then be offered to the next candidate on the merit list.
5. Every candidate coming from other Universities/Boards for admission to 1st year MBBS/BDS courses in the Colleges has to produce migration certificate at the time of admission.
6. Soon after the admission in the Medical / Dental College the students will get themselves registered on payment of prescribed fee with the University of Himachal Pradesh.
7. If a candidate is admitted on the basis of application form but at a subsequent time if it is discovered that any of the statement was false, the student shall be removed from the College and all the fees and other dues paid shall be confiscated. Any further action against the candidate and his/her guardian that may be considered suitable may also be taken.

7 (A) MIGRATION

The interested students may refer the rules of the Himachal Pradesh University and rules laid down by the Medical Council of India/Dental Council of India from time to time subject to fulfillment of eligibility conditions of the Himachal Pradesh University/Medical Council of India/Dental Council of India. For migration approval of the competent authorities shall be procured through the Director Medical education & Research, H.P.

(C) COLLEGE VACATIONS

Note : The vacations are divided into two parts 50% students work during each part of vacation of one month / one week.

8. FEES AND SUBSCRIPTION

1. For Govt. Institutions:

Newly admitted students must pay their fees in full within the prescribed period, which will be notified by the College office. No student's name will be enlisted in attendance register unless he/she has paid the prescribed fees. The seat of the student, who does not pay the

fees within the prescribed period, shall be declared vacant and filled by admitting another candidate from the waiting list.

2. The fee structure as mentioned above in respect of Private Dental Colleges is also applicable for NRI candidates. However, the Hostel charges as applicable in the private dental colleges concerned shall be paid by the candidates accordingly.

1. Fees will be charged for full calendar month and not any part thereof. The total College and Hostel fees will be paid in two installments in the Month of March and September or as notified or of the 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th year students except newly admitted first year students. The first installment of College fees will consist of half of the tuition fee and all the private charges and the second installment will be charged with the remaining half of the tuition fees. The first installment of hostel fees will be charged half of the hostel fees inclusive of electricity and water charges and heating charges plus the remaining other charges in full. Second installment will consist of the hostel remaining fees inclusive of

electricity and water charges plus heating charges.

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2. The fee should be deposited by 15th of the month in which it becomes payable without the late fee and upto the last day of the month with late fee of Rs. 10/- per day. No notice will be displayed for depositing the College/Hostel fees and it will be students, responsibility to pay the dues in time. Failure to pay all fees and other dues in full by the last of month by which they are payable shall automatically entail removal of the students name from the roll. He/she however may be re-admitted on payment of arrears of fees plus re-admission for of Rs. 500/-. The Principal is however, empowered to grant exemption of fine in deserving cases.

Note:- 1. In case, the last day fall on Sunday or a holiday, the fees shall be payable on the next working day.

2. The complete counselling prospectus for filling up MBBS/BDS State Quota Seats on the basis of merit of AIPMT-2015 in Govt. Medical/Dental Colleges and private Dental Colleges of State of Himachal Pradesh will be uploaded in the Websites of the H.P.
