Clinical diagnosis	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- pain and vague swelling- restricted movements of the neighbouring joints
Investigation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- X-ray- MRI- core needle biopsy
Treatment	Curettage and bone grafting (auto or allo)
