

Benign Bone Tumours - Ivory Osteoma

Clinical features	Bony (ivory) hard in consistency, 1 or 2 cm in size, over a flat bone, usually frontal bone asymptomatic unless the deeper extension is pressing on the brain which is unusual
Investigations	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- X-ray- CT Scan if necessary
Treatment	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Asymptomatic lesions left alone- Excision of symptomatic ones or for cosmetic reasons
