

Benign Bone tumour – Osteoid Osteoma

Clinical diagnosis	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- vascular and very painful,- can produce symptoms of arthritis- can produce symptoms of arthritis
Investigation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- X-ray- CT scan- MRI if necessary
Treatment:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Excision in toto (enbloc in cortical bone)- curettage in cancellous bone;- In inaccessible locations – radiofrequency / laser ablation under CT guidance- curetted/excised material sent for histopathology
