

Benign tumourous conditions – Simple Bone Cyst, Aneurysmal Bone cyst & Fibrous Dysplasia

Clinical diagnosis	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- nothing specific except painful swelling, not large- may present with pathological fracture
Investigations	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- X-ray- CT scan- MRI- needle biopsy
Treatment	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- curettage and bone grafting- if the patient has a pathological fracture, limb is immobilized in plaster cast till the fracture unites and then curettage and bone grafting carried out or- the lesion is curetted and bone bone grafted and at the same time the fracture is internally fixed.
