

## STANDARD TREATMENT GUIDELINES FOR CEREBRAL PALSY

<b>Clinical Diagnosis</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- prenatal, perinatal and post natal</li><li>- Spasticity</li><li>- non-progressive motor impairment</li><li>- affect movement and posture</li></ul>
<b>Investigations</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- motor power evaluation by MRC grading</li><li>- gait analysis</li><li>- MRI of the brain</li><li>- Electromyography</li><li>- Complete Haemogram, Bleeding time, Clotting time, Complete urine examination for pre-anaesthetic checkup</li></ul>
<b>Treatment</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- non surgical treatment like botulinum injection</li><li>- tendon transfer</li><li>- osteotomies/tenodesis</li><li>- tendon lengthening</li><li>- tenotomies, capsulotomies and arthrodesis</li><li>- PVC splints and Braces, Calipers</li><li>- Physiotherapy</li></ul>
